Using a monochrome scheme the result achieved is a highly contemporary, clean cut and simplistic finish that flows throughout in harmony.



The pink hues spotted, have taken on hints of neutral tones, making it the perfect backdrop to incorporate


other neutrals or bolder accent colours, to create various design statements desired.
